WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Lewisham being the local planning authority for the said Borough are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be corried out on such parts of the land shown edged with black dashes on plan No.PD 83/1 annexed hereto and known as numbers 1 to 39 inclusive Collins Street Blackheath London SE3 in the said Borough (hereafter called "the said land") as are set out in the corresponding column of the schedule hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (hereinafter called "the Order")

AND WHEREAS the said Council is satisfied that the exercise of their powers under Article 4(3)(b) of the Order is necessary as the said development constitutes a threat to the amenities of their area

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Order (and in particular by Article 4(3)(b) thereof)

HEREBY DIRECT that:-

- (1) The permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply
 to any development of the description set out in Column 1 of the Schedule
 hereto on such parts of the said land as are set out in the corresponding
 part of Column 2 of the Schedule hereto
- (2) This Direction shall remain in force for six months from the date hereof and shall then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date
- (3) This Direction may be cited as "the London Borough of Lewisham (Collins Street) Article 4 Direction 1980
